expedition-bound!

From June 10 - July 1, 2007 Manifest will host our first Creative Research Expedition to Greece. The three-week trip and creativity workshop is now open for registration to students, professionals, and the adventurous public. The trip price, excluding transportation to Greece, is \$3500. SOMETHING from NOTHING

Our current exhibit, Something From Nothing, opened to the public on November 10th. Conceived and curated by Elizabeth Kauffman, the exhibit brings together five professors and four students from Alabama, Colorado, Indiana, Massachusetts, and Ohio. Works on view include photography, painting, sculpture, mixed-media, drawing, digital prints, and installation. Pictured at left is Althea Murphy-Price, professor of printmaking at Indiana University, in the process of creating her piece for the exhibit. Untitled (Hair Rug), is a screenprint of sorts, with the artist sifting synthetic hair clippings over a carefully prepared patterned fabric template, then removing the fabric to reveal the final and very delicate piece. About this work the artist states that she is interested in the importance of physical appearance and its fleeting inevitability. This is but one excellent example of the irony that pervades Something From Nothing. The show will be on view through December 8th. A full color catalog is available.




