(These same supplies will be used in each month's class)

Pigments (OIL PAINTS* (37 ML TUBES)

* Good brands include Gamblin, Winsor and Newton, Grumbacher, and/or Williamsburg. However, any brand of oil paint that is not student-grade will work.

(Be careful: Student-grade brands like Winton, Georgian, and Artists Loft do not offer sufficient value for your money. Also, please do not buy any color that ends in "hue" ... this is not the same as cadmium, for example.)

Titanium White
Cadmium Red
Alizarin Crimson
Ultramarine Blue
Viridian Green
Lemon Yellow
Ivory Black

Surfaces

Canvas boards
Stretched canvases
Gesso boards, etc.
(Student's preference)

Brushes

Select bristle brushes only. The hairs should feel coarse and stiff, unlike soft synthetic or sable brushes. Below are some suggestions, but not requirements for sizes/shapes

Rounds, Flats, and Filberts – Sizes #1, #3, #5, #7

Mediums

150 ml. tube of Winsor and Newton Liquin Impasto medium
Odorless Mineral Spirits (Gamsol, Mona Lisa, Turpenoid)
Solvent container (any dish with sealing lid will work, but a silicoil or solvent can will be available at most art supply stores)

Additional supplies

Rags or paper towels
Sketchbook
