Course Description

This workshop will introduce methods for designing and drawing fantastic creatures using various animal anatomy as observational reference. Participants will gain a firm understanding of the design process, from thumbnail sketches to a refined concept that is ready for commercial application. The workshop will include a live demonstration by Bobby Rebholz and a specially coordinated visit to the [Geier Collections and Research Center](#), where participants will have the opportunity to draw from their extensive 70,000-square-foot facility of zoological specimens.
